**1st Japanese–German Summer School:
“European, German and Japanese Environmental Law”
August 9th to August 17th, 2018 in Kassel**

Based on a new cooperation contract between the Universities of Kassel and Fukuoka, our 1st Japanese–German Summer School on Environmental Law will present an overview of European, German and Japanese environmental law. Main themes will be how environmental protection is handled in Europe, as well as legal policies concerning water and the environment, energy policy, environmental protection and power plants in Japan.

The Summer School is planned for students from both Fukuoka and Kassel University. There will be lectures, presentations and exams as well as a cultural program.

The courses and exams will be held in English.

For those interested from Kassel University, master courses Environmental and Energy Law and Business Law:

You can get up to 6 ECTS points (3 plus 3 by upgrading) by participating in the Summer School for the “Internationales und europäisches Umweltrecht” course. There will be different courses handling European, Japanese and German environmental law, where current legal problems will be illuminated.
